# **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This course offers a broad range of artistic skills and experiences in many different disciplines e.g. drawing, painting, ceramics, sculpture, digital art, video art and photography. It is designed to allow students to develop a portfolio of artwork suitable for applying to courses in further study, e.g. university degree. The course also encourages personal development and a sound basis for working from an art studio. It provides a pathway to higher qualifications such as a diploma or degree.

## AND

A LAPTOP COMPUTER capable of processing all the software required for the course would be a major advantage, particularly with wireless networking. Software required for the course can be purchased at student discounts through the College after payment of college fees.

### FURTHER STUDIES:

On successful completion of this qualification, pathways exist to higher level study in the Creative Arts.

#### **EXIT POINTS:**

Learners who exit the Certificate II in Visual Arts prior to completion may request a Statement of Attainment for units satisfactorily completed.

#### **APPLICATION / ENROLMENT**

Application forms for full time study are available from the Australian International College of Art Head Office and the Australian International College of Art website and should be submitted to the Head Office. (Intakes occur twice yearly – February and July).

#### ASSESSMENT / AWARD

Assessments may be conducted through oral, written and practical methods.

On successful completion of this qualification, students will be eligible for CUV20103 – Certificate II in Visual Arts.
